**ORDER
and
IMPOSITION OF FILING RESTRICTIONS**

Pursuant to the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, and 28 U.S.C. § 351 *et seq.*, the Judicial Council has reviewed complainant's filings, construed as a Petition for Review, and hereby affirms the February 23, 2009, order of Circuit Judge Deanell Reece Tacha dismissing the captioned complaints of judicial misconduct. The Petition for Review is denied.

Complainant was directed to show cause why the Judicial Council should not restrict complainant from filing future misconduct complaints, upon Judge Tacha's conclusion that complainant's misconduct complaints were duplicative and amounted to an abuse of the misconduct procedures. *See* Misconduct Rule 10(a). Complainant's responsive filings did not address the order to show cause.

The Judicial Council hereby prohibits complainant from filing further judicial misconduct complaints based on the same issues, claims, and allegations as set out in complainant's previous complaints. *Id.* Any further misconduct complaints based on the same issues, claims, and allegations as set out in previous matters or on

rulings in those matters will be returned to complainant unfiled.

The Circuit Executive is hereby directed to sign, enter and distribute this Order to all parties as Secretary to the Judicial Council.

The dismissal of the complaint is hereby AFFIRMED.
