ORDER AND JUDGMENT*

Before MATHESON, BACHARACH, and PHILLIPS, Circuit Judges. **

This matter is before the court on the parties' *Joint Motion to Remand for Further Proceedings*, in which they jointly request that the court "revers[e] the district court's order and remand[] the case for resentencing with instructions to calculate the revised Guidelines range before exercising its First Step Act discretion." Upon consideration and review of the record, the court:

A. Grants the motion;

B. Reverses the district court's order [ECF No. 1926] denying
 Mr. Thompson's motion to reduce his sentence under the First Step Act and the district court's order [ECF No. 2007] denying in part Mr. Thompson's motion for reconsideration of ECF No. 1926;

- C. Remands this case to the district court to conduct any further proceedings that may be appropriate in light of the precedent identified in the parties' joint motion for remand; and
- D. Vacates the deadline for the government to file a response brief in this appeal.
