GENERAL ORDER

Before **TYMKOVICH**, Chief Circuit Judge.

Effective June 15, 2020, the Byron White United States Courthouse will reopen only to members of the public who have pending business with the court (e.g., a case- or other business-related need to enter the courthouse). Entry to the courthouse will be subject to the [updated access restrictions set forth in the Byron White Reopening Protocol effective June 15, 2020](#). Individuals who do not have pending business with the court, and/or individuals who refuse to comply with the aforementioned access restrictions will not be permitted to enter the courthouse. Effective July 1, 2020, the pending-business restriction will expire unless the court orders otherwise; beginning July 1, 2020, the courthouse will reopen to the general public in compliance with the aforementioned access restrictions. Counsel and parties who wish to file documents or submit paper

paper copies person are strongly encouraged to use the Clerk's Office [drop box](#) located just inside the front door of the courthouse.

Effective July 1, 2020, the requirement for parties to submit paper copies of briefs, appendices, and petitions for rehearing en banc will be reinstated. Paper copies will be required for all briefs, appendices, and petitions for rehearing en banc filed on or after July 1, 2020. Paper copies of briefs and appendices filed from March 17, 2020 through June 30, 2020 may be required via separate orders issued in individual cases.
